• Use an overview chart





#### 1. Green Machine Features

- ♦ 51.5 miles per gallon: 18% more
- ♦ Hybrid engine: 70% less CO₂
- Quieter: 8 db less noise

Economic and environmentally friendly!

#### Problem

- Font point size is too small
- Long sentences
- Noisy background

#### Solution


- Use a large point size
- Avoid sentences
- Use a simple background



- Font is too small




#### How to Make Visuals: Guidelines

# **Guideline 1: Show Images**

Show the audience your information by changing words and numbers into images.


• Change a confusing table of numbers into a graph.



• Change a list of locations into a map.



• Change words into a flow chart.




## **Guideline 2: KISS (Keep your Information Short and Simple)**

• Simplify sentences into easily remembered key words and phrases.



• Eliminate unnecessary information.



• Eliminate unnecessary details. Round off numbers and eliminate extra words to make easily remembered key points.
